I hope you enjoy looking back at some of the highlights from this term and look forward to welcoming everyone back to school as soon as possible.

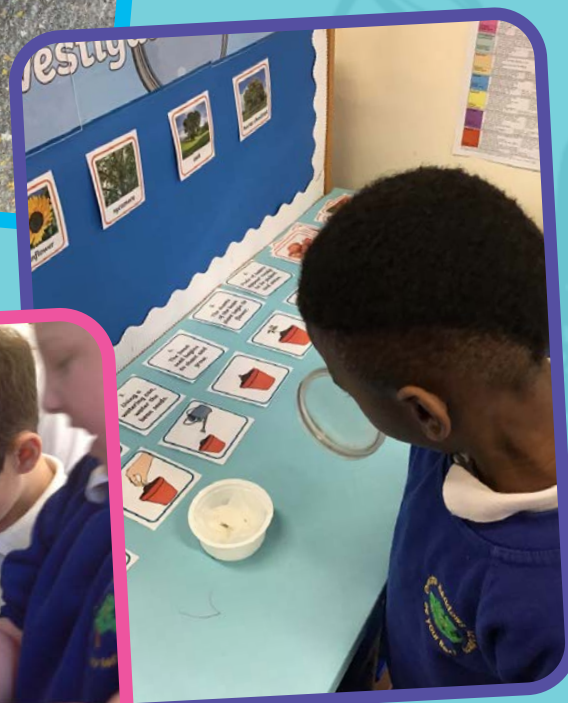
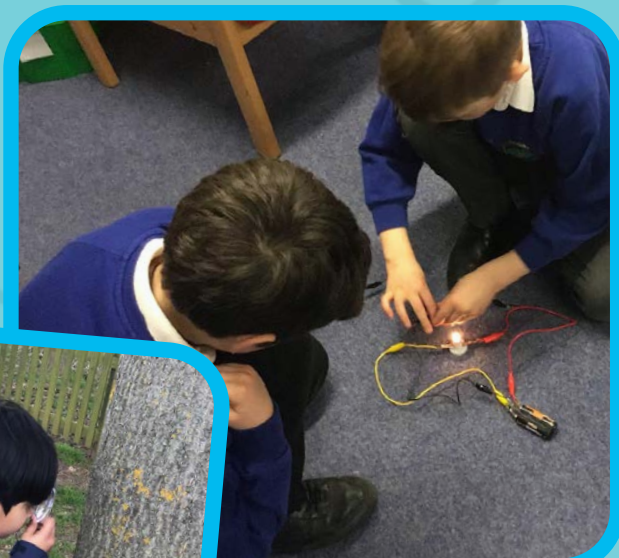


In response to the devastating wildfires in Australia we spent a day learning about the country and held a non-uniform day which raised £230 to support the wildlife and communities.

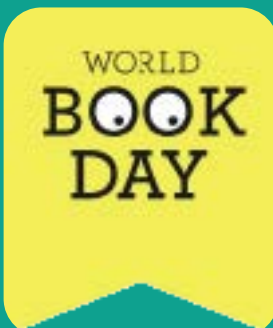


Super Science
