We will be learning about different types of homes, talking about our own homes and looking at homes in the past. The children will be building homes and talking about what makes a home a special place.




We will be looking at making sensible choices, following instructions and learning to learn from mistakes. The children will be exploring the themes of friendship, rules and kindness.




We will be learning about what a worry feels like and how to deal with worries. We will talk about making friends, thinking about our trusted adults and exploring ways to share any worries we have.

Key Learning



The children will be learning how to use numicon. They will focus on ordering, 1:1 correspondence for accurate counting, identifying numerals to 10 and learning how to represent numbers.



Phonics lessons will start week beginning 2nd October We use Read, Write Inc to teach the set one sounds. Physical Development: Fine-motor: The children will be learning how to use different onehanded tools and exploring different lines. Gross motor-The children will use a range of bikes, climbing equipment and focus on developing ball skills.

Personal, Social Emotional Development: We will be exploring friendship. Using a range of books such as 'Meesha Makes Friends' 'Do You Want To Be My Friend? Understanding of the World: We are going to start to think about the changing seasons and making links to changes in our natural world as Autumn approaches.

We will look at the themes of: Homes old and new, looking at different types of buildings in Peterborough such as The Cathedral. We will be looking at people who help us in school and in the community.
