Communication with teachers

<u>Attendance</u>

After five weeks in school our current school attendance is **95.7%** Well done to the **106** children who currently have 100% attendance. Our academy target this year is to acheive at least 95% attendance with only 15% of the school with under 90% attendance (over 20 days off for the school year).
