Year 4 – Johnsons of Old Hurst – Thursday 13th February 2025

On Thursday, February 13th, Year 4 will have a wonderful chance to visit Johnsons Farm, near Huntingdon, to support our Science topic on 'animals and humans.' During our visit, your child will enjoy a guided tour of the animals, which will include lions and crocodiles. Additionally, the children will take part in an interactive 'rainforest' experience, where they will learn about the different layers of the rainforest and even get to meet and handle a reptile!

The trip will cost £18.50 for each child. This fee includes the coach ride, entry to the zoo, and the rainforest interactive experience. However, if we don't receive enough voluntary contributions to cover these costs, the trip will have to be cancelled. Pupils should wear school uniform, warm coat and comfortable shoes. They will need a packed lunch and an extra snack if desired, in disposable containers or bags. There's no need to bring pocket money, but please make sure they have enough drink for the day, avoiding cans and fizzy drinks. For those who qualify, a free school meal will be provided and an order form will be sent out shortly. The coach will leave at 9 am prompt and will aim to be back for the end of the school day, dependent on traffic.

We will need a parent volunteer, therefore if you are able to volunteer on Thursday 13th February, please let Miss Ward know about your interest and will be in contact with you in the near future to confirm.

Please complete the consent from and make payment via your online iPay by **Friday 31**st **January**. If we do not receive your response by this date, we will assume your child will not be attending the school trip, and they will be assigned to an alternative class for the day.
